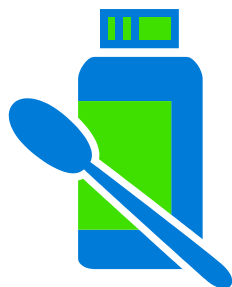

Illness and Infection

Illness	Exclusion from school for:
Diarrhoea & Vomiting	48 hours from last episode of illness
Chicken Pox	5 days from onset of rash
German Measles	5 days from onset of rash
Hand, foot and mouth	None
Impetigo	Until lesions are crusted or healed
Slapped cheek	None
Shingles	Exclude only if rash is weeping
Warts & Verrucae	None
Conjunctivitis	None
Head Lice	None - however treatment is recommended where live lice have been seen
Cold sores	None
Threadworms	None

Administering of Medicine

The school will not give your child medicine unless it is prescribed by a doctor and you have completed and signed the appropriate form, kept in the office. On the reverse of the form a record will be made of any medication given.

Anti-biotics can be stored in a fridge and should be handed in each morning by and collected at the end of the school day.

The school will not administer pain killers (tablets) or liquids such as Calpol unless expressly asked to do so in writing from your child's Doctor.

Please note that this is a service that the school is not obliged to undertake, and also that the school must be notified of any changes in writing.
